Approve Ordinance 2021-105 “AN ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance of General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), in one or more series, taxable or tax-exempt, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,900,000 for the purpose of currently refunding the City’s outstanding street loans, financing various capital improvements within the City, and paying for costs related thereto.”
