**Discussion:** The additional funds the city will be receiving from the American Rescue Plan Act made it necessary to amend the previous draft appropriations handed out at the last City Council meeting.

Commissioner Tim Krug moved to Award the 2021 Street Reconstruction Project to O'Brien Civil Works Inc, Seconded by Commissioner Melanie Cozzi.

He reminded everyone that the Ogle County Fair is being held from July 28<sup>th</sup> to August 1<sup>st</sup>.
