City Administrator:

- Dustin Runyon with our Water/Wastewater department has successfully completed his second certification and now has his Class C Public Water Supply Operator as well as his Class 4 Wastewater Treatment Works Operator licenses. Great job Dustin!
- Continue to work on the Trestle Ridge PUD.
- I attended the Ogle County Finance Committee meeting to present answers as it relates to our Economic Development grant application. They indicated that they would provide \$17,250.00 toward our Comprehensive Plan Update. It will go to the Ogle County Board for Approval next.
- Met with Mayor Williams and Comm Schuster to discuss EV plans, as well as discuss ARPA funding options.
- Worked with Commissioner Cozzi on the City Event at the Farmer's Market on 07/21/22. This is a great way to interact with the public in a fun setting.
