Sustainability Ad Hoc Committee Meeting

The Sustainability Ad Hoc Committee met Monday August 12th, 2024, at 9 am.

Steve Rypkema said he was approached by the AOP committee and was asked if the committee would be willing to help with recycling efforts. The Solid Waste Department would provide the containers, but the committee would need to distribute and tend to the containers during the festival. The committee seemed open to the idea.
