Commissioner Collins explained to the Council that on January 15th a a meeting was held with Larry Moring to go over the proposed agreement for solid waste disposal. There were some changes made in the agreement and copies of the new agreement were distributed to the Council. After discussion on a few minor changes in the agreement, Commissioner Collins moved that the draft agreement for solid waste disposal and curbside recycling be approved conditioned upon review of final contract and approval of same by himself.

Attorney Smith advised that on the Tenth Street property there are two different sections of the statutes which we can sell the property under. One is advertising for bids, which wasn't successful. The other allows the City to sell by realtor but the value of the property must be determined by a written AMI certified appraisal. The first appraisal the City had was just a realtor's appraisal. Then the Council has to pass a resolution authorizing it to be sold by listing it with a local real estate agency. Then they can sell it at not less than 80% of the appraised value. The Council agreed to go again with the bids and have an ordinance and motion to publish for bids at the next meeting.

Mayor Barnes advised that the County Building Code is getting closer to being finalized.

Commissioner Crenshaw moved to go into Executive Session to discuss acquisition of real property.
