Commissioner Lauer requested permission from the Council to order a truck for the Water Department from the State. This would be a one ton truck costing \$11,400.00. The total cost with a box would be approximately \$16,000.00. The deadline to order through the State is March 31, 1990.

Mayor Barnes reviewed a letter he received from Century 21 asking permission to place American Flags on the terraces of main thoroughfares in the City on July 4th. The Council agreed it was an excellent idea.

John Priller asked if Commissioner Lauer had looked into the possibility of tree replacement since the last council meeting. Commissioner Lauer advised that he has checked with some other communities. Commissioner Lauer suggested that he and Priller work together on this and maybe have a small committee to review reforestation in the City.

Mrs. Brass complained to the Council about the repair of her private water line. She feels the City should have taken care of it.

Frank Spielman questioned the Planning Commission meeting time and location. It will be at 5:30 P.M. on April 16, 1990.
