Commissioner Lauer advised that the downtown sidewalk replacement will be started this week or next.

Attorney Smith suggested that a plaque with the names of the Sesquicentennial Committee be placed on the clock somewhere and maybe chimes could be purchased with the money that was given to the City by the committee.
