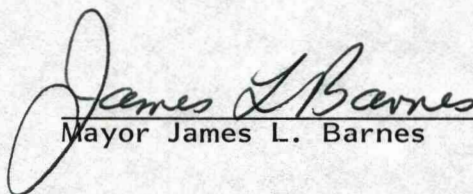

There being no further business, Commissioner Crenshaw moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Jim Lauer.

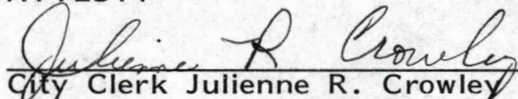
