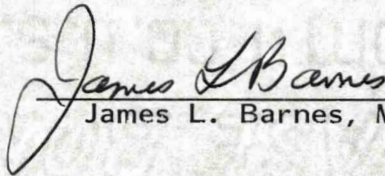
Commissioner Lauer advised the City will have monthly brush pick up starting the first Monday of the month from April through November, weather permitting.

Seconded by Norman Collins.

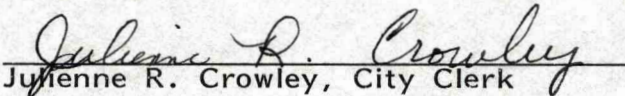
