Attorney Smith stated he felt it should not be up to the establishment to determine what is reported. Logan feels that Section 213G needs more work on it. Commissioner Collins suggested that the liquor committee work on this ordinance some more. No action taken on this ordinance.

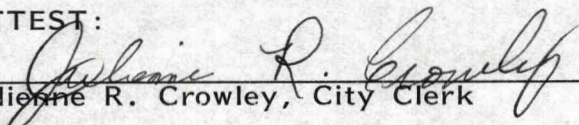

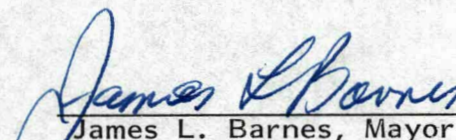
