She stated that they have tried to find a place to park the truck but haven't found a place. Also that in the winter time it has to be plugged in to prevent the air lines from freezing. The Council assured her that a group of citizens cannot introduce an ordinance. Engelkes asked that if an ordinance would come up before the Council that the ordinance would not be passed unless the City was willing to find a secure place for drivers to leave their trucks.


There being no further business, Commissioner Aurand moved that the meeting be adjourned.


