Bernie Klingenberg, Willett, Hofmann & Assoc. representative, presented a water sewer increase proposal to keep the city in compliance with the bond ordinance. The proposal for water is to go from the existing rate for water from \$7.60 to \$8.20 for the minimum up to 3,000 gallons and sewer from \$6.00 to \$6.60 for the minimum then the basic user rate from \$1.10 to \$1.30 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 3,000 gallons for water and from \$1.30 to \$1,50 per 1,000 gallons in excell of 3,000 gallons for sewer.

The Council instructed Klingenberg to draw up an ordinance and get it to Attorney Smith for review before the next council meeting. The rates will be effective as of February 1, 1998.
