The Council of the City of Oregon met in special session Thursday,

January 19, 1984 at 10:00 A.M., City Hall Building.

After reviewing the draft permit and the addendum to the facility plan, which is a part of the draft permit, Commissioner Svoboda moved that the addendum be submitted as it is and a letter be sent to the Illinois EPA that the city council has no comment on the proposed permit at this time. Seconded by Commissioner Braden.
