The ambulance service declined the offer through their attorney, Don Manzullo, and advised that the service was no longer available until they got their own insurance coverage. Byron ambulance is on stand-by for the Oregon ambulance. The Council agreed that if the ambulance service does not have coverage by the weekend that the City contract with an ambulance service to have an ambulance in Oregon over Autumn on Parade weekend.

Mayor Barnes will notify the city attorney this evening to make the offer again for the ambulance service to be on the City payroll. If they decline, other arrangements will be made for the weekend.
