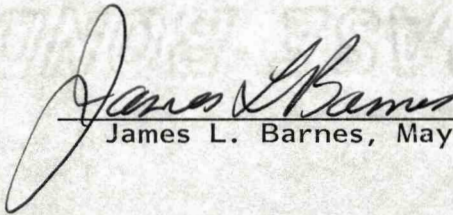

Seconded by Roger Logan.

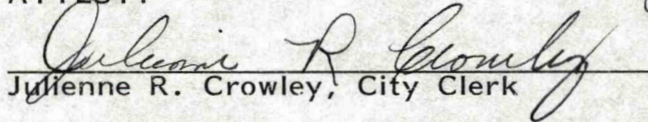
