seconded by Chrissie Myers.

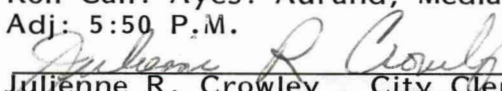

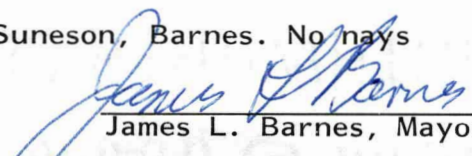
Commissioner Aurand advised the Council that Project Oregon has asked

the mountings. The cost of the mountings will be \$1400.00, \$35.00 each
for 40 trees. The Council agreed to pay this cost.

Holland to repair the pool for the amount of \$3,194.50. The Council
agreed to approve this proposal and for the work to be done this fall.
