The river crossing of the water line is less than 50% of the total contract for the water line.

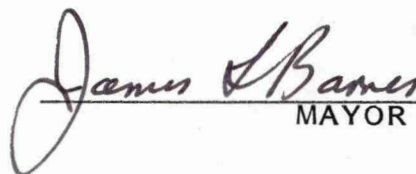
Mayor Barnes moved to extend the contract of Anderson & Dashney to lay the water line in the river crossing. Seconded by James Ludwig.
