Chief Miller gave the police activity report for the
month of October.

Commissioner Logan suggested that a discussion on the
complaint letters received at the last council meeting be
tabled until a full council was in attendance. The
Council agreed.

Commissioner Logan requested that a date be set for a
public hearing in reference to Illinois State Statutes
Chapter 24-11-74-3, establishing and defining a down-
town development and redevelopment district. He would
like to set the date for November 30 at 7:00 P.M.
and requested that a public notice be published in the
newspaper. The Council agreed.

Commissioner Lauer advised that he is having the snow
ordinance published for several weeks to remind the citizens
of the regulations, as he is going to have them enforced
this year.

Commissioner Lauer advised that the engineering recommend-
ations will be addressed at the next meeting.

The Council discussed TCI Growth, Inc.'s franchise and
agreed that Dan Pratt should attend a council meeting
to discuss it.

The Council discussed the Hydropower permit status
and instructed Attorney Smith to inquire about the status
and intentions of Rankin.

John Lindhorst requested that the city keep the sidewalks clear at the Yellow Bird and Johnston Plaza this winter. Commissioner Lauer advised that his department is going to keep the downtown sidewalks plowed this year.

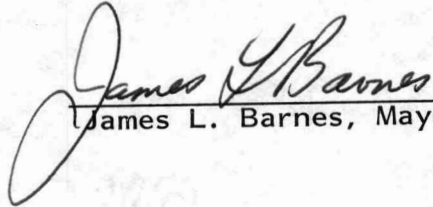
Citizen Request

Seconded by Jim Lauer.

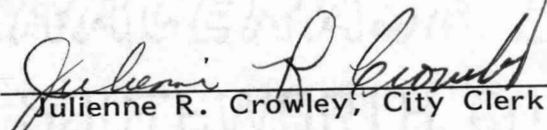
