He would like to set the date for November 30 at 7:00 P.M. and requested that a public notice be published in the newspaper. The Council agreed.

Commissioner Lauer advised that he is having the snow ordinance published for several weeks to remind the citizens of the regulations, as he is going to have them enforced this year.

Commissioner Lauer advised that the engineering recommendations will be addressed at the next meeting.

The Council discussed TCI Growth, Inc.'s franchise and agreed that Dan Pratt should attend a council meeting to discuss it.

The Council discussed the Hydropower permit status and instructed Attorney Smith to inquire about the status and intentions of Rankin.
