Mayor Barnes advised that Sgt. Minnis has requested to hold five vacations days over until next year because of some upcoming events. The Council approved the request.

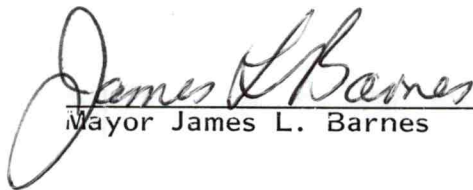
