Dennis Odens, representative of McClure Engineering, advised the Council that to comply with the NPDES permit, the ordinance would have to be revised.

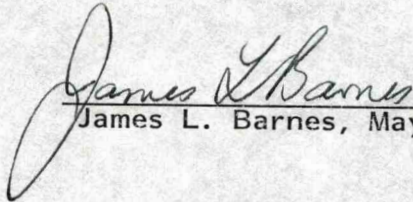
Mayor Barnes advised the Council that the Village of Progress had presented the City with a trophy for their support to the Village.

Mayor Barnes acknowledged Boy Scout Troop 81 for their attendance at the meeting.

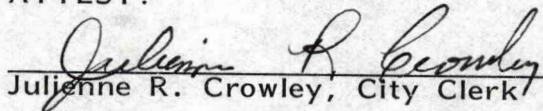
There being no further business, Commissioner Collins moved that the meeting be adjourned.
