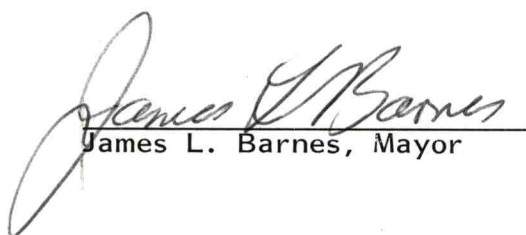

There being no further business, Mayor Barnes moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Ted Suneson.

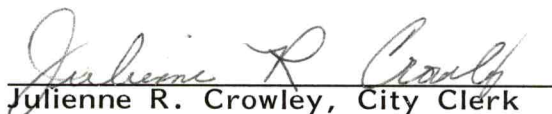
