Commissioner Jim Tegtmeyer met with someone from IDOT to discuss the plans for the Route 64 project. They would like to have the street lighting information as soon as possible to keep moving forward with the project. IDOT has approved a standard light. A meeting to pick out the light poles will be December 4, 2003 at 7:00 P.M. City Hall Council Chambers. The current individuals who donated funds to the street light program will be invited to this meeting for their input.

Mayor Tom Stone received a letter from the City of Woodridge thanking Officer Randy Cropp for helping with an employee get into their car. They had locked their keys in the car. He also will be looking into what organization is in charge of the decorations for the downtown.

Mayor Tom Stone attended a meeting at the Nuclear Plant. The meeting was to show the officials that security is tight at the plant.
