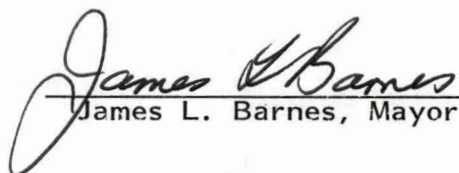
Reports

Seconded by Gerald Medlar.

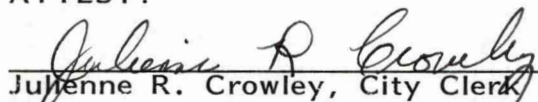
