The City Clerk reminded everyone that petitions for Mayor and Commissioners are due back December 11th-18th. Also there will only be one meeting in December on the 18th.

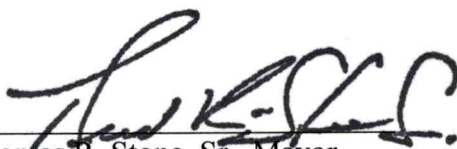

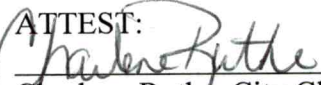
