There being no further business, Commissioner Aurand moved that the meeting be adjourned.

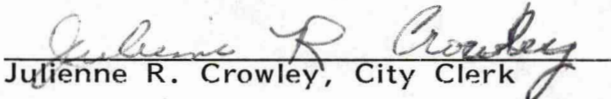
