Engineering

Commissioner Lauer read the tally presented by the City Clerk. Commissioner Lauer moved that the engineering firm of McClure Engineering and Associates be contacted and a date set to meet to negotiate engineering contract fees. Seconded by Gail Crenshaw.

According to law, if fee negotiations are not acceptable to the Council, the second choice firm will be contacted to negotiate.

Gerry McLain addressed the Council requesting the procedure that is going to be used to police downtown parking when the meters are taken out. Commissioner Lauer advised that signs will be posted stating 2 hour parking in each block. The tires will be marked and tickets issued, just as the parking meters are policed. There will be no obligation to the merchants to police the areas. It will be up to the police department.

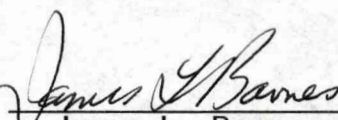
Citizen Request

There being no further business, Commissioner Lauer moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Roger Logan.

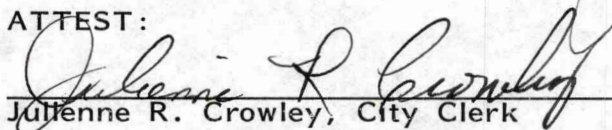
Adjournment
