be issued citations for the violations if his tenants
continued to park in the designated area.

Nohe and Jewett on Center Street and the alley between
Jones and Hastings off Route #64. The Clerk is to invite
the property owners to the first Council meeting

The Police Department demonstrated the use of the new laser training equipment to the Council and audience.

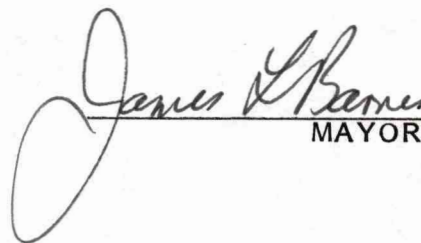
