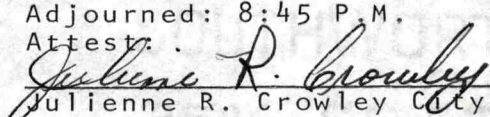
There being no further business, Commissioner Logan moved to adjourn. Seconded by Gail Crenshaw.

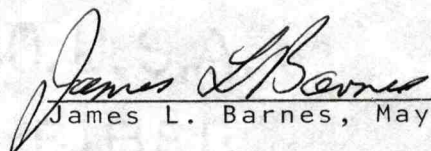
Adjournment
