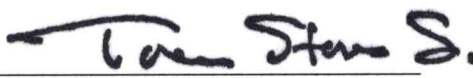
Commissioner Bob Rees announced that the water and sewer department has had

Commissioner Jim Lauer.

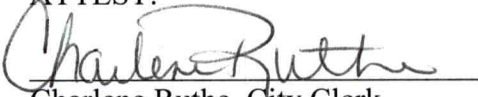
