Seconded by Chrissie Myers.

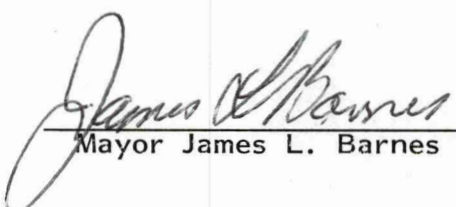
