Commissioner Bob Rees has been working with Matt Hanson from Willett Hoffman & Assoc. to update the cities facility planning map.

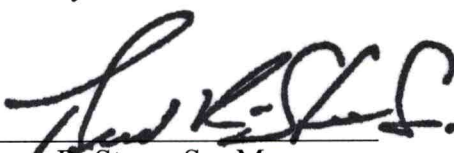

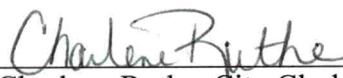
