Attorney Smith advised if it happens again, he will send a letter and advise them they will be assessed charges for the time and equipment to clean the sewer and fined.

Risley also reported a frozen water main going to Moe's Bait Shop on Second Street. He advised he has hooked Moe's up to water for now and in the future he will open the main during extreme weather.

Mayor Barnes asked the Council to review his recommendations for increasing the water and sewer hook up fees and they will decide at the next meeting.

Moe Kielsmeier, Moe's Bait Shop, expressed his complaint about the water freezing to his property.
