Klingenberg advised the Council that the flow monitoring for the Facility Plan would be done in May and June. The first draft should be ready by August and the final by December.

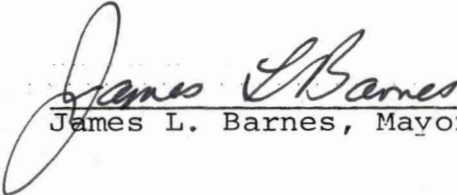
The Council agreed to raise the parking meter fine from \$1.00 to \$2.00. The ordinance will be ready for the next meeting

Seconded by Frank Svoboda.

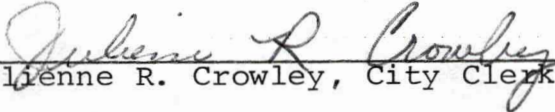
