Mayor Barnes asked the Council to consider purchasing an answering machine for the city hall phone for when the office is closed.

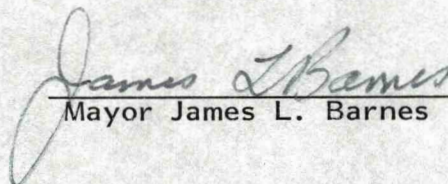
There being no further business, Commissioner Logan moved that the meeting be adjourned.

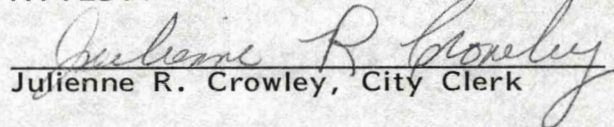
