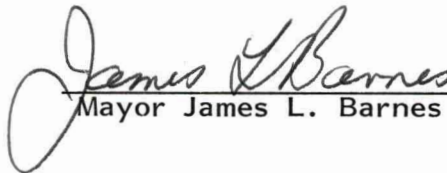
John Holob asked if there was anything new on the First Street railroad removal. Mayor Barnes advised that the last he knew, they were taking it out this summer.
