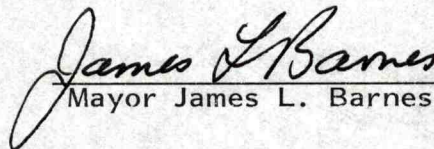
Mayor Barnes advised that the new clock would arrive Wednesday morning.

Seconded by Jim Lauer.

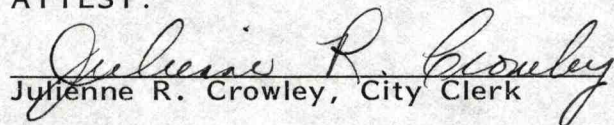
