All agreed it would be very worthwhile. Maxson and Fallon will submit a draft to the Council at a later date.

Chief Miller submitted bids for a new squad car from Bemis Motors, Oregon; Shaumburg Dodge, Chicago; and Thomas Dodge, Orland Park. The low bid was \$12,335.00 from Thomas Dodge, who has the State Joint Purchasing contract. The Council approved the purchase from Thomas Dodge.

Squad Car Bids

Chief Miller submitted the cost for the Physical Stress Test, Chemistry Profile and General Physical for the police department. K.S.B. Hospital cost - \$3,600.00 for nine officers. St. Anthony Hospital cost - \$1,917.00 for nine officers. The Council approved the initiation of the Physical Stress Test program and St. Anthony's bid for the physicals.

Engineer's Report

1. Dennis McMullen advised he would be attending the Grants Workshop on April 15 in Oglesby.

2. The Council advised McMullen to contact Don Gilbert to do the work on Rt. #64 near the fire station, since his cost estimate was under \$2,500.00. The work should be done before the State starts on Rt. #64 construction.

3. The cost estimate to seal coat East Oregon is \$63,000.00. The Council agreed they should get started now to have June bids.

The Council approved the V.F.W. request to have the bar open on Sunday, May 17, 1987 from 1:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. for hosting the Sixth District Meeting, per Sec. 4-250 of the City Code.

VFW Request

Commissioner Svoboda advised that the Burlington Railroad is going to disconnect their water service which also services a house at 1104 South Fourth Street. The new owners of this property were unaware of this situation and is asking if the City would participate to get water service to their residence which would have to come from one block north. Attorney Smith advised that the railroad should be responsible. Smith is going to write to the railroad in regard to this matter.

Mayor Reports

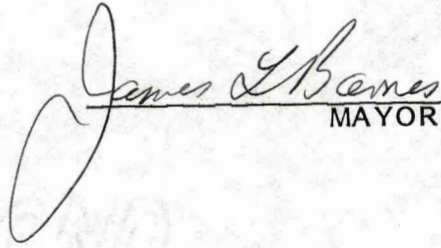

Seconded by Elma Braden.

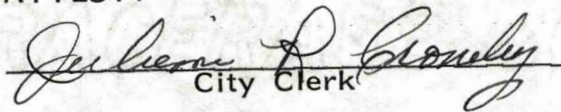
