The Council advised that everyone will pay for garbage. The only exceptions will be when someone vacations for the winter or for several months at a time and they call in prior to that time.

Chief Miller requests that the Council consider putting a 4-way stop sign at Fifth & Jefferson Street. Commissioner Ludwig approved the request and will have an ordinance drawn up.

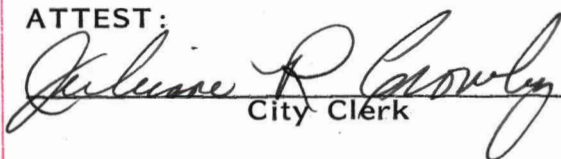
There being no further business, Commissioner Collins moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Elma Braden.

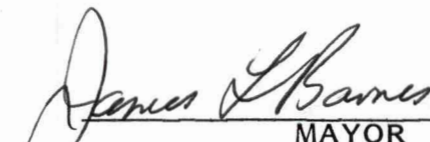
