Duane Davis, owner of property at River Road and Citizen Complaint and Route #64, addressed the Council with a complaint that his property was damaged when the water line was installed last year. The city engineer will inspect the property this week. The engineer and street department will look at this and advise. The Council advised that everyone will pay for Garbage Billing garbage. Chief Miller requests that the Council consider putting Stop Sign Request a 4-way stop sign at Fifth & Jefferson Street. Commissioner Ludwig approved the request and will have an ordinance drawn up. Commissioner Braden introduced Harriet Zimbelman. Animal Control. Zimbelman has been hired as the Animal Control Officer Officer. She will work a maximum of 28 hours per week at \$5.00 per hour.
