Donna Mann asked the Council to attend a Project Oregon Partnerships in Education Business & Education Forum to be held April 26, 1997 at Nash Recreation Center..

A representative from Oregon Bowl requested permission to have Post Prom at Oregon Bowl, as it has been in the past. A resolution will be drawn up to allow the event on May 17, 1997.
