Commissioner Jim Lauer announced that the storm sewer project is under way. The City also received a letter from Rueben & Delores Barnhart praising the w-s department for its prompt action on their blocked sewer line. Jim read the letter to the council.

Mayor Mike Arians announced that we had three organizations requesting funds this year. They are Yellow Bird, Village of Progress, and the Chana School. The three requests total \$12,000.00 dollars and only \$10,000.00 dollars was appropriated. Amy Trimble suggested that the different organizations write on the form as to what they plan on doing with the money. The Mayor suggested \$4,500.00 to Yellow Bird and Village of Progress, and \$1,000.00 to the Chana School. The Council agreed with his suggestion.

The Mayor will be meeting with the city engineer to discuss the logistics of the annexation for the subdivision and businesses north of the Fairgrounds Subdivision.

Wendy is looking into the cable franchise with Insight Communications. The Mayor has asked her because he has had complaints from citizens that the surrounding cities have a better package than Oregon.
