Mayor Barnes commended Commissioner Svoboda and the Water-Sewer Department on achieving the status of a nomination for an award on the Disposal Plant.

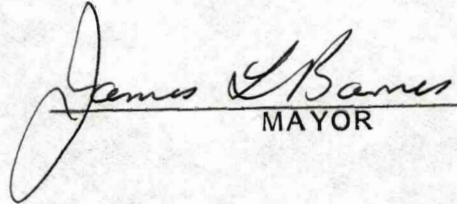

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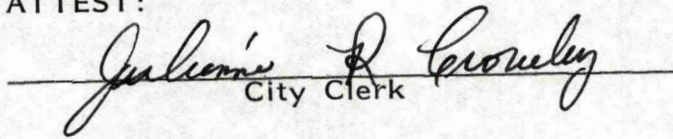
There being no further business, Commissioner Collins Adjournment
