Reports

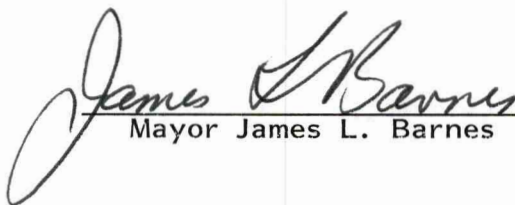

Seconded by Ted Suneson.

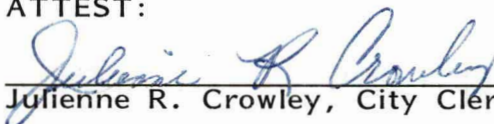
