 Commissioner Jim Lauer.

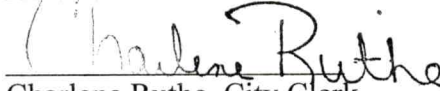

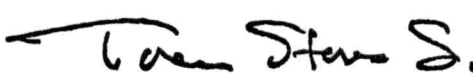
