Commissioner Collins moved that the City of Oregon participate in the 1985 summer band program whereby up to eight concerts, plus two pre-concert rehearsals, shall be paid for out of city funds, at a cost to the City for the season of approximately \$5,000.00 which covers rehearsals, concerts and director salary. He further moved that Kim Davis be appointed band director for the 1985 concert season. Her duties to include all concert arrangements and publicity. Her salary to be set at \$120.00 per week for eight weeks. Band members shall be paid at the rate of \$5.00 per rehearsal and \$7.00 per concert. Travel compensation to be paid to band participants as follows: 1-5 miles, \$1.50 per rehearsal or concert; 6-10 miles, \$2.50 per rehearsal or concert; 11 or over miles, \$3.50 per rehearsal or concert. The foregoing expenses to be paid out of City Band Funds. It was further stated that not over 50 members shall participate in any one rehearsal or concert. The band director will obtain approval from the Council before expending funds for miscellaneous purchases or other expenses.
