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Chief Miller presented the city council with a deposit ticket for \$471.50 from the Auxiliary Police. This was the proceeds from the spaghetti supper.

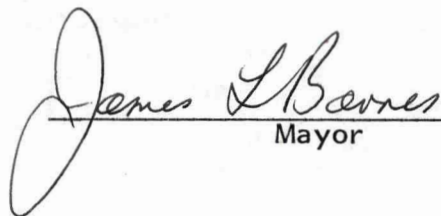

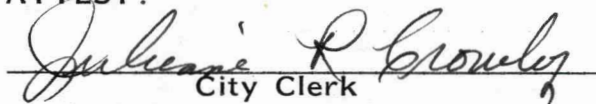
