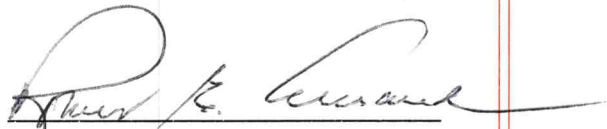
They also requested curb and gutter on Webster Street and that the road be repaired. They are to contact Commissioner Suneson on these matters.
