## COUNCIL MEETING MAY 29, 2001

The Council of the City of Oregon met Tuesday May 29, 2001, 7:00 P.M. Council Chambers.

Jim Lauer started the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Arians opened the meeting with a public hearing on the Annual Appropriation. The City Clerk stated that the amount of the appropriation was \$4,195,227.00. It's about \$484,000.00 more than last year. A few of the reasons for the amount being more than last year is the price of gasoline going up, the payments for the jetter and sweeper, and the IEPA loan for the storm sewer project. The public hearing was closed.

Commissioner Gerald Medlar moved to pass Ordinance No. 1162 the Annual Appropriation for the fiscal year May 1, 2001 to April 30, 2002, Seconded by Commissioner Jim Lauer.

Debbie Dickson the Director of Autumn on Parade asked if the City would be willing to pay for the entertainment the weekend of the festival. In the past the city has allotted \$1,200.00-\$1,500.00 for entertainment. The consensus of the Council was to approve the request.

Andy Robinson, Chairman of the Economic Development Commission spoke regarding the GIS Mapping System. The Economic Development Committee recommends the mapping system to the Council subject to the city being able to finance the project. Mayor Arians suggested that Curtis Cook, the County's engineer attend one of the June Council meetings to address the financing for the GIS Mapping System. The City Clerk will contact him and see if he can attend one of the meetings in June.

Commissioner Gerald Medlar moved to purchase land at Route 64 and Lovers Lane from Mabel Sharick for \$2,000.00, Seconded by Commissioner Amy Trimble.

Roll Call: Medlar, Trimble, Arians. Lauer abstained from voting. No Nays.

The Council discussed hiring an intern to help out in the Clerks office. They would be hired for minimum wage and working three to four hours a day. The City Clerk will be putting a job description together.

Chief Miller announced that officer Franklin would be leaving the police department in September and going into the Army. So he will be starting the process to hire a replacement.

Amy Trimble asked where we were with the Comprehensive Plan. She has not filled out the application from ComEd for some assistance in financing the plan. Mayor Arians would like to refer this to the Economic Development Committee.

Commissioner Jim Lauer stated that the Storm Sewer project is ahead of schedule.

The City Clerk handed out an estimate from Municipal Code to put the city ordinances on the Internet. This will be discussed at the next council meeting.
