Attorney Smith advised that he and Attorney Krahenbuhl are still working on the pre-annexation agreement.

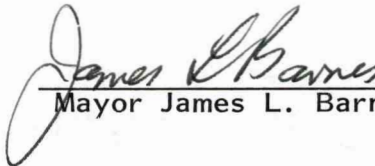
There being no further business, Commissioner Priller moved that the meeting be adjourned.
